Deadline for Registration: Entry Forms due by September 7

Participants are invited to submit original brick creations using LEGO® bricks. Submit your completed registration form to the Alamance County Arts Council no later than Saturday, September 7. Entries must be delivered in person to the Burlington City Park between noon and 6:00 pm on Friday, September 20 and 7:00 am and 9:00 am on Saturday, September 21. Judging will be by a panel of local community representatives. Awards will be presented at 1:00 pm on September 21. Entrants must be present in order to accept their award or the winner's prize will be forfeited to the runner-up. Where possible, participants are encouraged to leave their creations on display throughout the Carousel Festival weekend. In order to be eligible for prize awards, winning creations must be available for display in the lobby of Proponent Federal Credit Union, 3504 Forestdale Drive, Burlington through October 31, 2013.

Eligibility

Eligible age categories are Children, ages 6-9; Youth, ages 10-14; Young Adult, ages 15-20 and Adult, age 21 and over.

Prizes

- Children ages 6-9, 1st Place Winner \$500!
2nd and 3rd place winners, Choice of select LEGO set
- Youth ages 10-14, 1st Place Winner \$500!
2nd and 3rd place winners, Choice of select LEGO set
- Young Adult ages 15-20, 1st Place Winner \$500!
2nd and 3rd place winners, Choice of select LEGO set
- Adult ages 21 and over, 1st Place Winner \$1,500!
2nd and 3rd place winners, Choice of select LEGO sets

Judging

Entries will be judged on construction, use of parts, creativity and their overall completeness. There is no competition entry fee.

Building Challenge Rules

Use your own LEGO bricks and elements to build an original creation at home, indicate your intention to participate by returning the registration information by September 7. Then bring your creation to the Burlington City Park on Friday, September 20, 12:00 pm – 6:00 pm or Saturday, September 21, 7:00 am – 9:00 am for display and judging. Note: No vehicular access is permitted within the festival area after 9:00 am on Saturday.

- All entries must be removed from the festival area by 8:00 pm on Sunday, September 22.
- Use only genuine LEGO bricks, elements and pieces. Construction made from specially themed LEGO kits are not eligible and will be disqualified.
- Designs and constructions must be original.
- Contestants are not permitted any outside help from others and must enter solely as an individual and not as a team entry.
- You may enter only ONE creation per person. There must be a registration form on file.
- Entries in the Children, Youth and Young Adult categories must not exceed 18" x 18" x 18"
- Entries in the adult category may be larger, but must not exceed 36" x 36" x 36"
- Creations must be delivered to the Festival secure, with no loose parts, and ready for display. No construction will be permitted on site. Supporting platforms are allowed if necessary. Pieces may be reinforced with glue/adhesive for added security.
- Registration forms are available at the Alamance Arts Council and at artsalamance.com
- **Contest is open to 20 entries per category and is on a first-come, first-served basis. More than 80 entries may be accepted if display space allows.**

Guidelines

By submitting an entry form and piece into the contest, entrants and their parents/guardians agree to these official rules and regulations and the decisions of the judges and release the contest sponsors and the Alamance County Arts Council of all liability that could result from participating in the contest.

By submitting an entry into this contest, entrants and their parents/guardians grant permission to the Alamance County Arts Council and sponsors to use any photographs and/or videos of the entrant's submitted model for any promotional use.

Security is provided throughout the event and all possible care will be taken in the handling of entries. Entrants accept that the Alamance Arts Council, its employees, volunteers and/or governing board are not responsible for loss of or damage to any entry.
